RE: Regional Judging Requirements
DATE: June 2, 2006

Because of the recent decision by the Region 1 Administrative Committee to allow each individual state to determine the requirements to be considered as a judge at Region One Championship competitions the Southern California Administrative Committee has approved the following requirements:

Pick any three of the following each year (August 1- July 31):

- Attend the Region One Judges Clinic (held this year in conjunction with Region One Congress)
- Attend the Regional NAWGJ-SC Symposium
- Attend Region One Congress
- Attend a Regional Junior Olympic Camp (SCEGA is hosting one September 15-17)
- Attend USAG Congress
- In Gym Hours
- Attend the Southern California Base Score Clinic
- Attend Southern California Mini Congress

The intent is to offer a variety of options that are educational as well as considerate of individual personal budgets.

Judges selections for Regional Championships are made by the Region One Board at the August meeting held during Region One Congress. Obviously, it will not be possible to complete three of these options before August 2006. Judges who have completed at least one of the options will be considered for selection. Judges who are selected will need to complete the remainder of the requirements before the assigned competition.

The specific details still need to be worked out at the next Southern California Administrative Board Meeting. Meanwhile, my suggestion to you, if you are not planning to attend USAG Congress, Region One Congress or the Region One Judges Clinic, is to be sure you get in some "in gym" hours this summer. I suggest at least six.
